

Roosevelt Dancers - Roosevelt Dancers practices and performances

The Roosevelt Dancers are a non-profit 501(c)(3) organization whose mission is to provide “cultural education through Cambodian dance.” We provide free Cambodian classical folk dance instruction to children in kindergarten through high school in Tacoma, regardless of race or ethnicity. We also provide academic and social service support to our dancers and their families.

The Roosevelt Dancers perform an average of 20 to 30 times a year at schools, festivals, community events and conferences. We have been a national semi-finalist for the President's “Coming Up Taller” award, featured on Pierce County television, and are perennial performers at the Northwest Folklife Festival and Ethnic Fest.

We are available for performances in the Puget Sound region year round. Scheduling depends on the availability of our dancers, since they are all students, and the availability of proper transportation. We ask for a donation to help maintain our program since we depend entirely on donations and grants for our instructors, costumes, transportation, etc. Donations may range from \$50.00 to \$250.00 or more depending on the distance to the performance and length of the performance. The Roosevelt Dancers usually need at least a two week advance booking.
