#### About the composition of the Commission:

Members of the Landmarks Preservation Commission represent various areas of the city, as well as historic preservation-related professions and interests. The Commission is composed of:

#### **Architects**

(3) individuals who are currently or have been in the past professionally certified architects.

#### **Professional**

(4) individuals who have had professional experience or training related to Historic Preservation originating from employment or study within the following disciplines: Arts or art history, architecture, history, architectural history, planning, prehistoric and/or historic archaeology, conservation, construction or building trades, landscape architecture, urban planning or design, structural engineering, land use or real estate law, real estate, appraisal or real estate finance, project management or contracting, or a related discipline.

#### **At Large**

(3) At-Large positions.

#### **Liaison from the Tacoma Arts Commission**

(1) individual appointed from the membership of the Tacoma Arts Commission (currently vacant).

#### **Ex-Officios**

The City Council may appoint one resident, property owner, or business owner from each local Historic Special Review District or Conservation District to serve as a nonvoting ex officio.
